

In the coming weeks, I will be meeting with both parish councils to establish a joint committee that will help guide this collaborative process. We will also schedule informational meetings where you can ask questions, share concerns, and learn more about what collaboration will mean in practical terms.

I invite you to approach this journey with open hearts and minds. Change can be challenging, but when we place our trust in the Lord and in one another, change can also be a source of growth, renewal, and deeper faith.

Please know that my commitment to you is unwavering: I will shepherd both communities with the same care and attention, honoring the unique gifts and traditions that make each parish special while exploring how we might serve Christ more fully together.

Let us pray for one another, for wisdom in this process, and for the grace to follow wherever the Lord leads us. May our collaboration be a witness to the unity Christ desires for all His people.


