

Pastor's Sunday Reflection Fourth Sunday of Advent

In this powerful passage, we encounter Joseph at a crossroads of faith, facing circumstances that must have shaken him to his core. When confronted with Mary's unexpected pregnancy. Joseph's first instinct was to protect her dignity even in his confusion, planning to divorce her quietly rather than expose her to public disgrace. Yet God interrupted his plans with a dream that would change everything, calling him to step into a role far greater than he could have imagined. Joseph's "yes" to God required tremendous courage—he had to set aside his own understanding, risk his reputation, and trust in a divine plan he couldn't fully comprehend. As we stand on the threshold of Christmas, Joseph reminds us that faith often asks us to embrace mystery and move forward even when we cannot see the full picture. His obedience was not passive but active and costly, requiring him to love sacrificially and protect both Mary and the Christ child. In our own lives, we too are called to listen for God's voice, to trust when the way forward seems unclear, and to say "yes" even when it means stepping into the unknown. This Advent, may we find inspiration in Joseph's faithful response, remembering that God works through ordinary people willing to surrender their plans for His greater purpose.

Simbang Gabi will not be held at Blessed Savior this year. However, you are cordially invited to attend any of the other Advent Simbang Gabi Masses.




In the back of the church, there is a giving tree that is set up by the finance council. Please take an ornament. Each of them has a set designation for a particular
