

The hospitality committee would like to thank the community and those that stepped up with their time and bringing in food. Thanks to Gisele for sharing her decorations for the gathering as well.



Pastor's Sunday Reflection Second Sunday of Advent

In this season of waiting, John the Baptist calls out to us from the wilderness with anurgent message: repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near. His voice echoes across the centuries, reminding us that Advent is not merely about nostalgic preparation for Christmas, but about genuine transformation of our hearts. John stands at the Jordan River, clothed in camel's hair, proclaiming a baptism of repentance—and the religious elite who come to him receive not comfort, but challenge. He warns against placing our confidence in spiritual pedigree or past achievements, insisting instead that true faith produces fruit worthy of repentance in our daily lives. As we light our Advent candles and prepare our homes, John asks us to examine what needs to change within us to make room for Christ. The One who is coming, John tells us, will baptize not just with water but with the Holy Spirit and fire—a promise both wonderful and sobering. This Advent, may we have the courage to let John's prophetic voice disturb our complacency and prepare our hearts for genuine encounter with the living God. Let us clear away the debris of our pride, hypocrisy, and self-righteousness, making straight paths for the Lord who comes to dwell among us.
