in advance by calling the parish office.



Pastor's Sunday Reflection

Reflection on Luke 7:11-17

In today's Gospel, we encounter Jesus at the gate of Nain, where a funeral procession carries the only son of a widowed mother to his burial. Jesus, moved with compassion, stops the procession and raises the young man to life, restoring him to his grieving mother. On this Feast of All Souls, we remember our beloved dead and find profound comfort in Christ's power over death itself. Just as Jesus wept with those who mourned and brought hope to the hopeless, He stands with us in our grief for those we have lost. This passage reminds us that death does not have the final word—resurrection and eternal life are God's promise to all who believe. As we pray for the souls of the faithful departed, we trust in the same compassionate Lord who once said, "Young man, I say to you, arise!" Let us hold fast to the hope that one day, all tears will be wiped away, and we will be reunited with our loved ones in the joy of God's kingdom. Today we commend all souls to the Lord's tender mercy, confident in His love that conquers even death.
