Weddings: Arrangements are to be made at least one year in advance by calling the parish office.

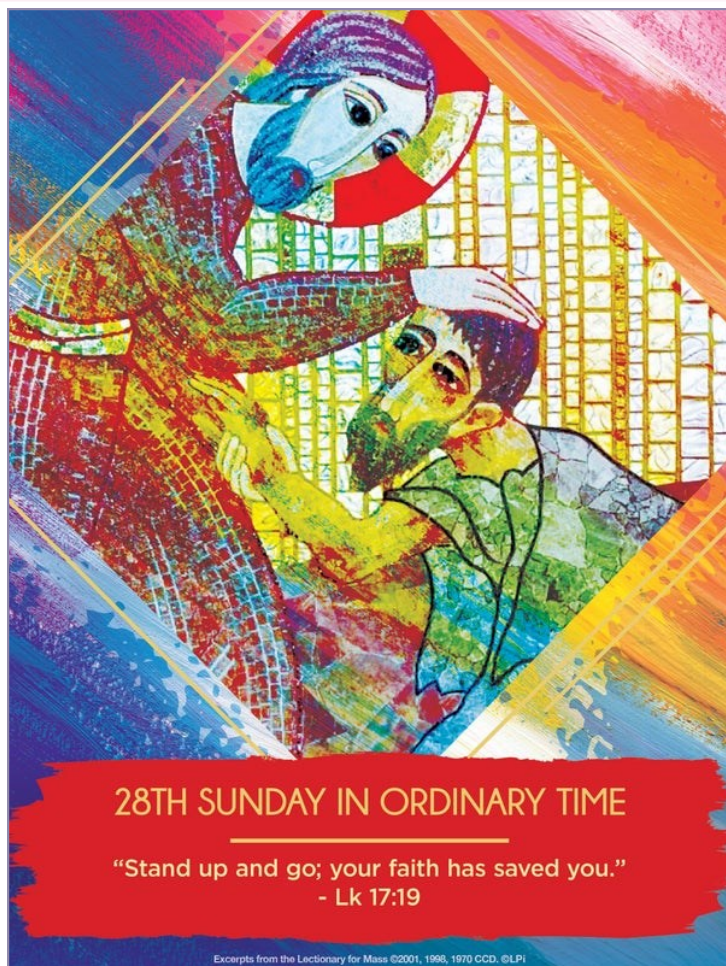

Pastor's Sunday Reflection

The Grateful Heart

Reflections on Luke 17:11-19

In Luke's Gospel, we encounter ten lepers who cry out to Jesus for mercy, their voices carrying the weight of isolation and desperate hope. Jesus responds with compassion, instructing them to show themselves to the priests, and as they obey in faith, their healing unfolds along the journey. Yet of the ten who received this miraculous gift of restoration, only one—a Samaritan—returns to fall at Jesus' feet in gratitude. This man's thanksgiving wasn't just polite courtesy; it was the overflow of a heart transformed by grace, recognizing not just physical healing but encountering the very presence of God.

Jesus' question, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine?" echoes through the centuries, gently challenging our own hearts about gratitude. How often do we rush forward with our newfound blessings, forgetting to pause and acknowledge the Giver? The returning leper teaches us that true healing encompasses both body and soul—it's not complete until it drives us back to worship. In a world that often takes God's goodness for granted, may we choose to be the one who returns, whose gratitude becomes a testimony to others of God's faithful love.
