

**BLESSED SAVIOR
PASTORAL COUNCIL NOMINATIONS**

The **nomination** process to fill 3 three-year positions on the Pastoral Council commencing **July 1, 2022, begins today and continues through the next two weeks.**

All nomination forms are due by May 15, 2022.

They can be turned in through the offertory collection at Mass (please fold form) or at the Parish Office. Additional nomination forms are in a basket on the table near the vesting room. All nomination forms must include the name of the person making the nomination.

Members of Blessed Savior Parish are invited to nominate yourself or other Parish Members whom you believe have the spiritual and leadership qualities to serve Blessed Savior Parish. Other requirements include: a baptized Catholic at least 18 years of age, an active Registered Member of Blessed Savior, not an employee of our Parish nor an immediate family member of an employee. Members may nominate more than one individual.

The Pastoral Council is a consultative body that acts as a wisdom group to the Pastor. The Council is prayerful, faithful, pastoral, representative, discerning, prophetic, empowering, and collaborative. Leadership qualities include vision, service, confidence, consensus, awareness of needs and resources, welcoming, and spiritual.

All nominees will be contacted by Council Members to confirm their willingness to serve. Those accepting are expected to view an online Archdiocesan Orientation Session (<https://www.archmil.org/offices/parish-councils/Webinar-Parish-Council-Nominees.htm>). The process will culminate with Discernment at the Pastoral Council meeting on May 17th. The new members will attend the Pastoral Council's Transitional Meeting on June 21.
